The continuing support of the local community through volunteering in the shop, donating goods to sell and coming in to buy has meant we have been able to give out a total of £24,000 in grants to good causes within the Parish during 2023. The pantries are kept supplied by donations from individuals in the parish, from Fareshare in Aboyne, and thanks to generous cash donations from, among others, the Bread of Life Charity Shop and Torphins Golf Club Senior Men.
