The Church is not just a building!



Built 150 years ago, and completely modernised 10 years ago, the Church complex in Torphins is the place we go to worship each Sunday. But it isn't just for Sundays, or for weddings, baptisms and funerals. The building is available every day, for everyone, and our Church reaches much wider into the community.

The regular activities at the Church Complex are:

Mondays – exercise class; yoga; sewing group; Guild (second Monday of the month)

Tuesdays – two yoga sessions; Pilates; knit and natter; garden gang

Wednesdays - bridge club; Notes from Torphins choir

Thursdays – Pilates; coffee and chat with home bakes - free!

Fridays – yoga and mahjong; youth club (first Friday of most months)

Saturdays – a quieter day, but available for parties and other private events

And on **Sunday** of course there is our regular morning worship at 11.00, with Sunday Club for school age children, starting in church and then leaving for their own activities after the first part of the service. Communion is held on the first Sunday of every second month, and Messy Church family activities sessions take place roughly quarterly on Sunday afternoons.



The Church complex is also the emergency hub for Torphins run by TORCH (Torphins Community Help)

In addition to the church complex in Torphins our church hall in Lumphanan is also used by community groups and we have parish pantries located in our three villages from which people can freely take what they need, and anyone can support by donating to them.

MDC also runs a busy charity shop, the **Bread of Life**, at 6 Craigour Rd, Torphins.

Our Christmas Charities

CrossReach is the social care arm of the CROSSREACH Church of Scotland and has been providing a wide range of services for over 150 years.



In 2024 CrossReach supported 28,500 people across Scotland with needs including dementia, learning disabilities, mental health problems, homelessness, and substance misuse as well as offering services for children, families and older people.



ShelterBox is an international disaster relief charity that provides emergency shelter and essential household items to some of the world's most vulnerable people displaced by natural disasters and conflict, most recently in Jamaica following hurricane Melissa.


Hardship Fund
